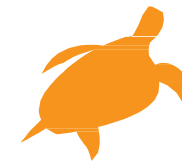
OBJECTIVE 6

OBJECTIVE 7

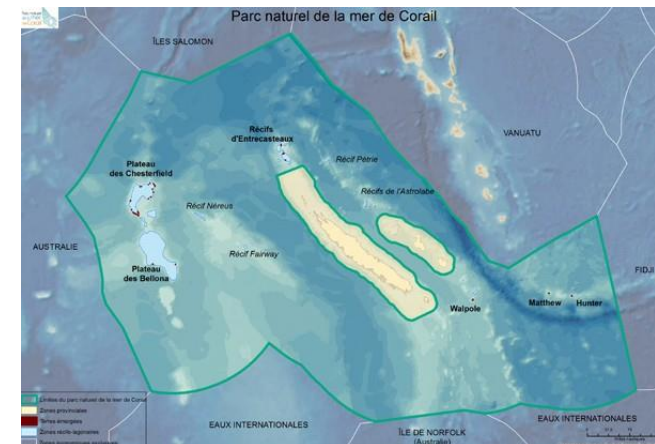
Try to **limit** the impact of maritime transport on the ocean environment in terms of maritime traffic and pollution risk.



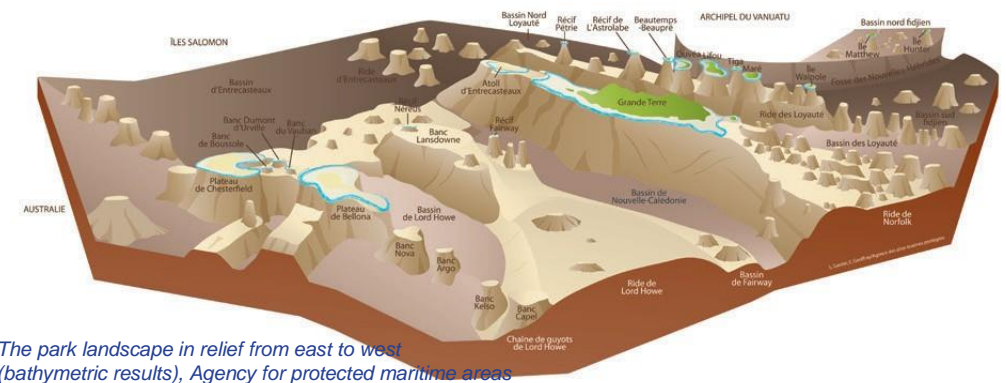

OBJECTIVE 13

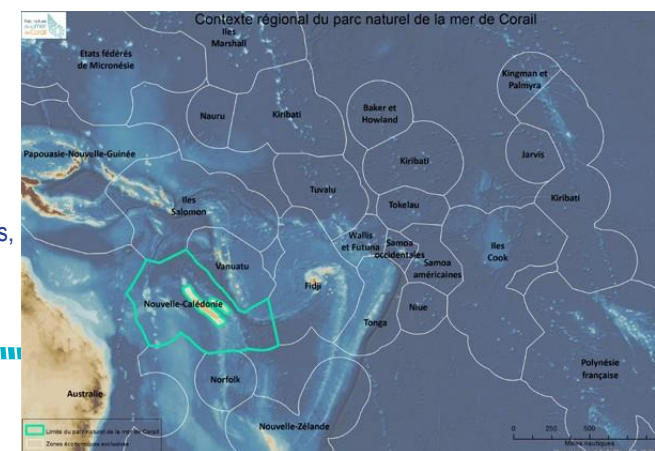

A summary will then be drawn up and included in the draft management plan which will be submitted to the government at the end of April 2017.
